Protec Ducks Gameday Guidelines

- No spectators are allowed into the building. Livebarn will be accessible to view games. Mite players will be allowed to have one parent per child present during games.
- To keep things flowing, away teams should park on the left side (closest to the retention pond) and use that side for warm up activities. The home team should park on the right side and use that side for warm ups.
- Players need to enter the building fully dressed, including skates. Benches and rubber mats will be set up at our front entrance for skaters to put skates on. Locker rooms will be closed and off limits to players. We suggest bringing hard skate guards for entering and exiting
- Players will use the front doors to enter the building and the emergency exit in the rink they are playing to exit the building
- Goalies will be allowed to come in to put their pads and skates on inside the building
- Hockey bags will not be allowed into the building, we suggest bringing a zip-lock bag for mask storage or a small drawstring bag. Items brought into the building will need to be taken over and stored on the game bench.
- Players need to line up outside the front doors 20 minutes before game time to enter as a team and receive temperature checks. The home team will line up on the right side and the away team on the left side.
- Outside organizations will need to complete a health check form and have a representative (coach or manager) hand completed forms in at our temperature check table. Managers can hand in roster stickers at the front table as well
- Players need to make sure they have their own water bottles. There will be absolutely no sharing of water bottles allowed on the bench. Water fountains will not be in service.
- There will be no handshake line at the end of the game, players will line up on the blue line and salute the opposing team.
- Players **cannot** take their equipment off in the building and need to exit in a timely manner so we can prepare and sanitize for the next game.
